INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CONTESTANTS

- ▶ Late comers will not be allowed to participate in the competition.
- Participant should make their own arrangements for lunch.
- Xpress Math, being a competition with multiple rounds, may last the entire day.
- Admit card is essential for registration. The participants should produce their admit cards for registration on the day of the competition.
- ▶ The preliminary rounds and the final rounds would be conducted on two seperate days.
- ▶ The National Prelims would consist of both the written round and the oral round.
 - **Written round**: The written round would comprise of 60 questions. The participants are expected to answer maximum number of questions within 30 minutes. Each correct answer is awarded 8 marks and 2 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.
 - **Oral round**: Oral round will comprise of 25 questions. Participants are expected to answer maximum number of questions within the time limit allotted to each question. Oral round is intended to assess the mental computing capability of the participant. Pencil, paper, calculator computations will not be allowed.
- ► The qualifying mark to the National finals would vary from centre to centre and would depend on the average performance at each of the respective centres.
- ▶ Qualifiers from each categories from each location is selected after the national prelims and will be eligible to participate in the national finals.
- ▶ Parents will strictly be not allowed inside the premises where the competition is conducted. The wards of the intruders would be immediately disqualified.
- Participants will have to pay ₹ 1200 by way of DD/M.O in favour of MaRRS Word Master Pvt. Ltd. Payable at Mumbai. Write the name of the child, CIN, school, class, category, contact no., email ID, and name of the competition on the reverse of the DD. The DD has to be sent to Marrs Word Master Pvt. Ltd., Avillion Greenfields, A Wing, Shop No. 30, Ground Floor, Jogeshwari Vikhroli Link Road, Andheri East, Mumbai 400 093. The last date for submission of the DD is 20 April 2016. In case of any exemption provided on genuine grounds, a late fee of ₹ 500 will have to be paid. Please note that the fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
